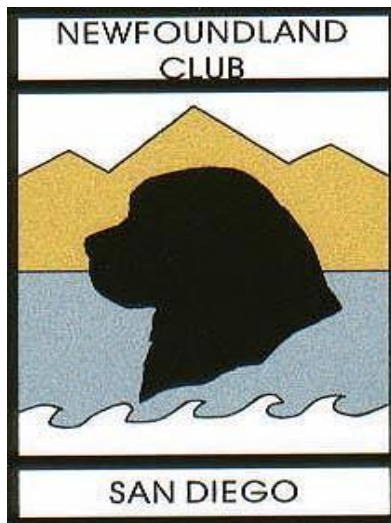

**These Water Tests are approved by the Working Dog Committee of the Newfoundland Club of America (NCA) and sponsored by Newfoundland Club of San Diego and Newfoundland Club of Southern California.**

## Test Information

**Entry Opening and Closing Dates:** Entries open for NCA members on August 18, 2015 and open for everyone on August 28, 2015. Entries of NCA members received after August 28th will not be given priority over those of non-NCA members. Entries postmarked prior to August 18th for NCA members and August 28th for non-NCA members will not be accepted. Entries will be accepted by mail only and must show a visible postmark. If you send entries via next day mail, please sign the "Waiver of Signature" space. Closing date for entries is September 18, 2015 at 10:00 pm.

**Entry Limits:** Entries for each day are limited to a total of 20 entries regardless of division entered and regardless of how many entries are received for each division. The first 20 entries that arrive or are pulled in a lottery would get into the test regardless of their division. Entries over the limit will be placed on an alternate list. Openings will be filled from the alternate lists in the order received. If entries exceed the entry limit, a lottery will be conducted for each day. There will be a minimum of 1 entry for each division in order to hold the test.

**Re-qualifiers:** Re-qualifiers will be accepted as space allows; untitled dogs will be given first priority even if their entry is received after that of a titled dog. Re-qualifiers in Junior Division MAY NOT post-enter Senior Division. However, new titlists in Junior Division MAY post-enter Senior Division. Dogs may be entered in more than one division on the same day, but only if they have already qualified at previous tests in all of the divisions entered. If the entry for the test exceeds its limit and a lottery is necessary, the dog may not get into each division entered. There will be no substitutions for dogs to change divisions if their entry is chosen for one division but not the other in a lottery. Judges must excuse any dog not in condition to finish the division entered and, if so, the dog will not be able to continue in any other division entered that day. Entry fees will not be refunded for dogs that are excused. Entrants are discouraged from pushing their dogs beyond their limits.

**Entry Fee:** First entry \$45 per entry, \$35 for additional entries and post-entries of the same dog on the same day. Please make checks payable to NCSD for Saturday entries and NCSC for Sunday entries (two checks required if entering both days).

**Required Forms:** Entries must be made on an official NCA entry form, and a copy of the entered dog's AKC, ILP/PAL, or foreign registration paper must be attached.

**Water Test Regulations:** These tests are conducted in accordance with the NCA Water Test Regulations effective January 1, 1999 and updated March 2015. Exhibitors are responsible for reading and understanding the current regulations in their entirety. Test Regulations are available at a cost of \$5.00 per copy from the NCA Working Dog Committee Publications Contact, Dwight Gorsuch, at 6282 Burris Road; Rock Hall, MD 21661-1100. **Description of the Test Site:** Glorietta Bay is a saltwater site. There is ample green grass and trees for shade. If you have a tent or shade, it is a good idea to bring it. The test site is occasionally windy in the afternoon. The beach is clean and the water is typically very clear. There is a moderately quick drop off. Most dogs will be swimming within ten feet. Ample parking is usually available. There is no fee to park. This is a public park and dogs being tested are allowed with special permission. Therefore, only entered dogs are allowed and must be leashed or crated while not testing. Thank you for your understanding.

**Schedule:** There is no pre-test practice planned. Saturday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>: Check in time with test secretary from 8:00-8:30 am, the test will begin with the WRDX division at 9:00 am. Sunday, October 4<sup>th</sup>: Check in time with test secretary from 8:00-8:30 am, the test will begin with the WD division at 9:00 am. *Entrants not present for the published check in time will not be judged that day.* Awards will be presented at the conclusion of judging each day

**Parking at Test Site:** There is typically ample parking and it is free of charge.

**Bitches in season:** Bitches in season will be allowed to participate, but will be judged after all other entries have completed the entire test. Please notify the secretary in advance if you have a bitch in season. Bitches that have had an ovarian sparing spay are required to be tested as bitches in season.

**Dinners:** There will be no-host dinners at local restaurants on Friday, October 2<sup>nd</sup> and Sunday, October 3<sup>rd</sup>. Please contact Test Chair, Debby Rothwell at (562) 936-1259 if you would like to attend (All are welcome.).

**Morning Hospitality:** A continental breakfast will be provided for participants, stewards, and judges the morning of the test.

## **AGREEMENT**

I (we) acknowledge that the NCA test regulations have been made available to me (us) and that I am (we are) familiar with their contents.
